

# Terms & Conditions

**Y**ou are responsible for your use of the services, for any Content you post to the Services, and for any consequences thereof. The Content you submit, post, or display will be able to be viewed by other users of the services.

**Y**ou may use the Services only if you can form a binding contract with Open and are not a person barred from receiving services under the laws of the United States or other applicable jurisdiction. If you are accepting these Terms and using the Services on behalf of a company, organisation, government, or other legal entity, you represent and warrant that you are authorized to do so. You may use the Services only in compliance with these Terms and all applicable local, state, national, and international laws, rules and regulations.

**Y**ou can only join **Open** if you agree to our terms. If you break any rule or disobey the policies of **Open** then you might be banned or removed from **Open**.

**Y**ou can only join **Open** if you're 13 or over 13. We will not ask for your birthday in the signup process, because you can only sign up if you have an E-Mail. E-Mail accounts are only available for specific age groups.

**I**n some cases, your account will be removed or blocked when you don't use Open by its rules and regulations. If your account has been blocked or removed then you should not create another account.

**B**y giving us your E-Mail, you are acknowledging that Open will send you E-Mails. The E-Mails sent will not contain SPAM, Advertisements or other malicious things.

**T**here are no restrictions in contributing to Open. You can contribute as you like. By signing up, it doesn't mean that you should contribute. It's your decision whether you contribute or not.

**T**his document's laws and conditions are applicable to every individual / organisation who have signed up for using the Open Network.

# Safety
